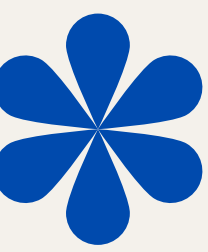
ISC (Class XII)

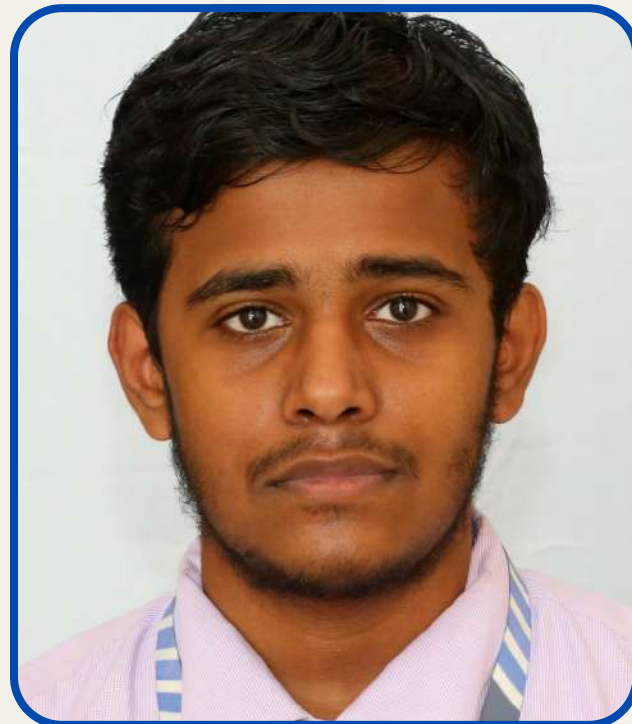

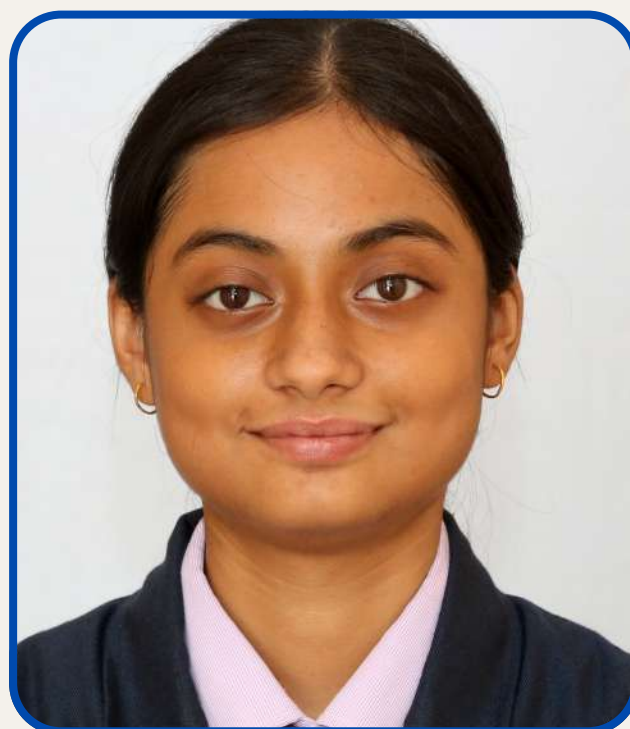

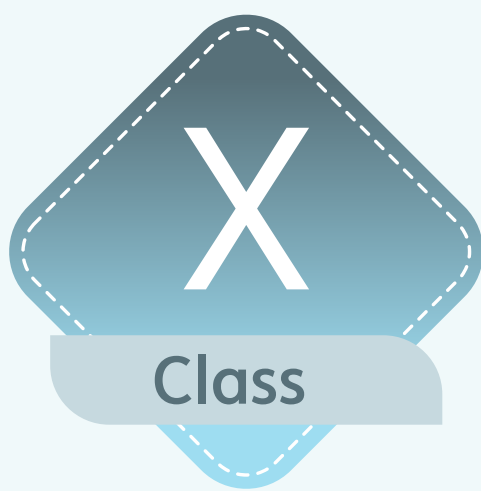
The Rising Vanguard

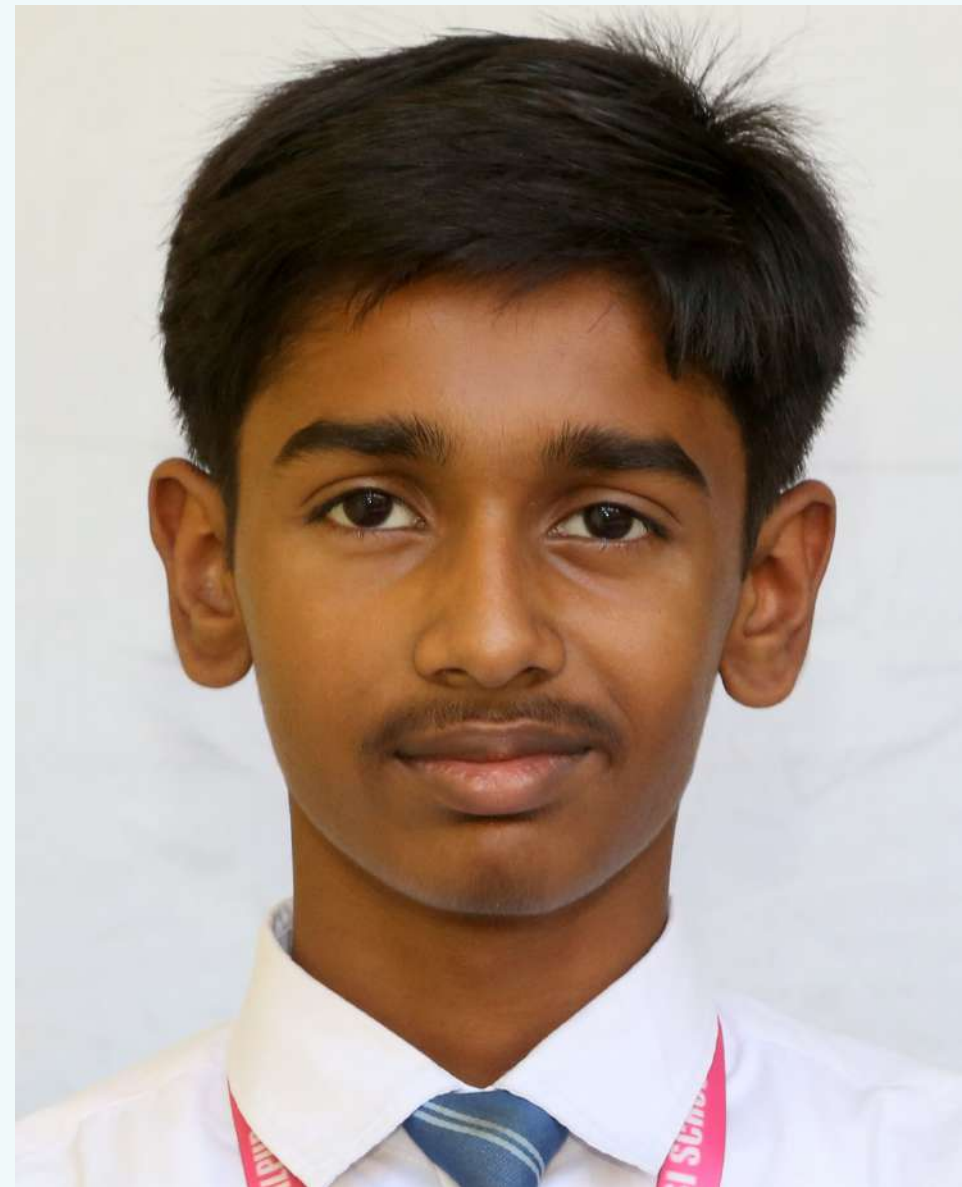

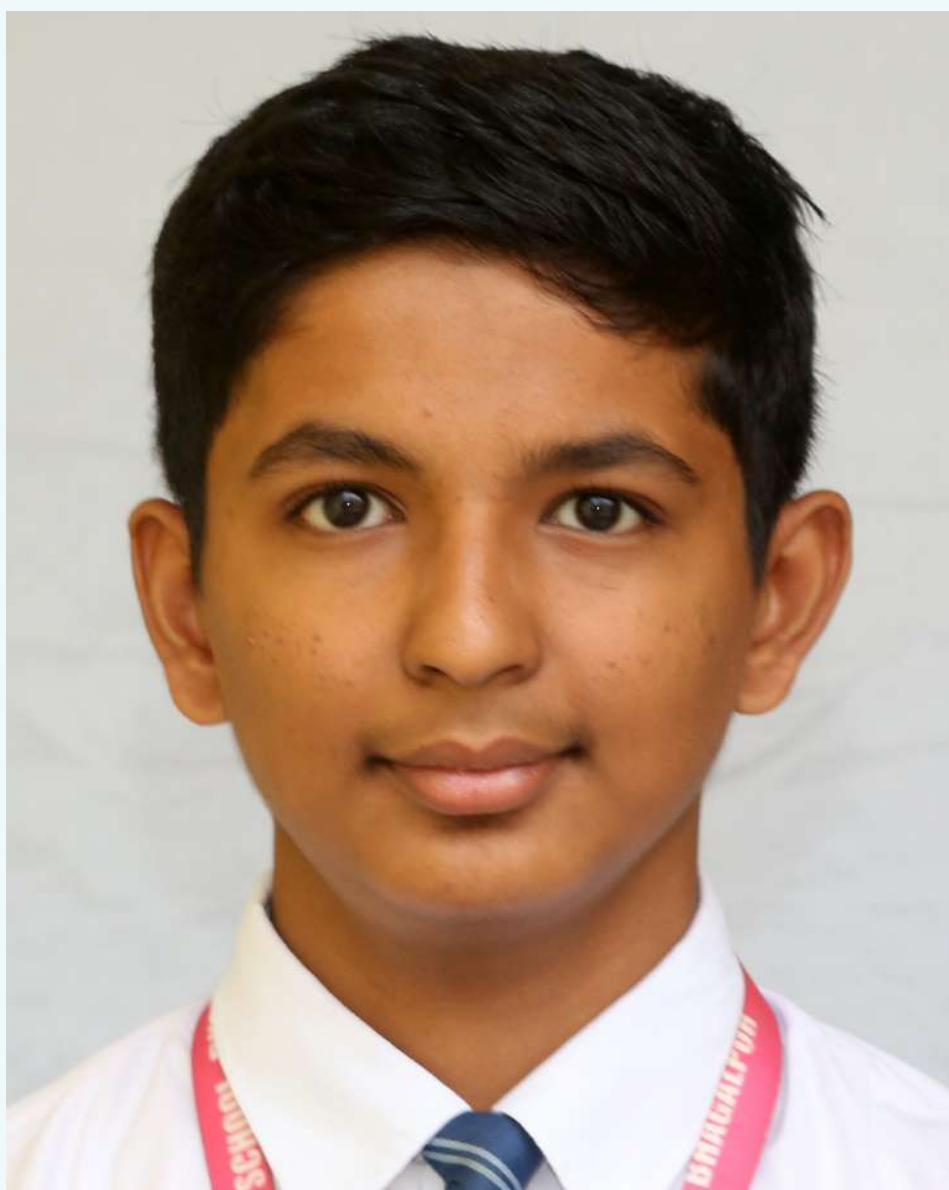

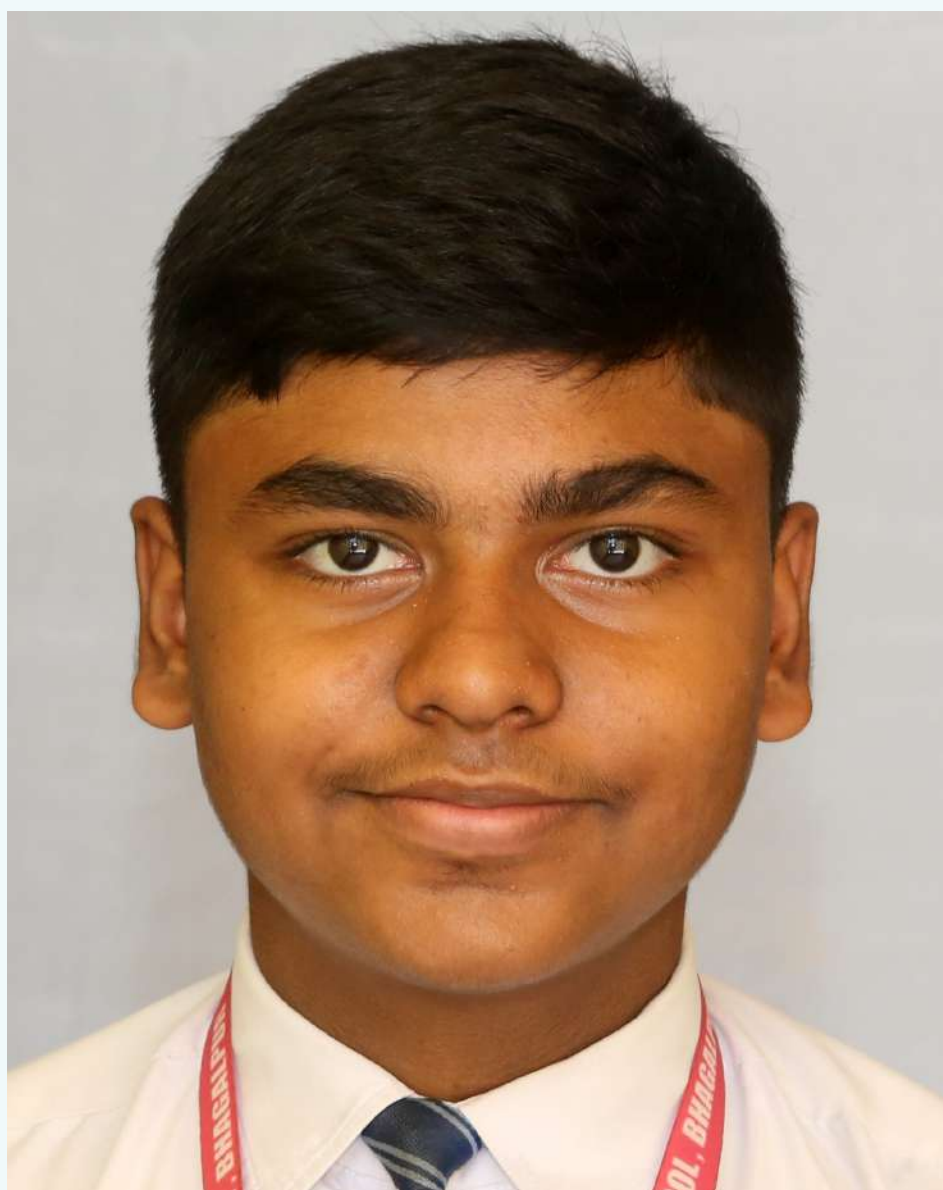

LABOUR DAY

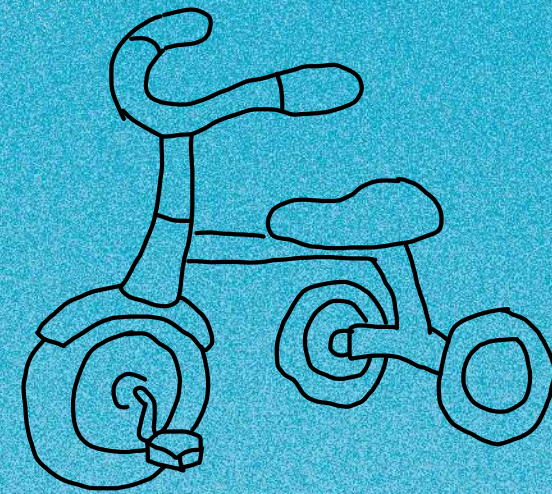
CELEBRATION

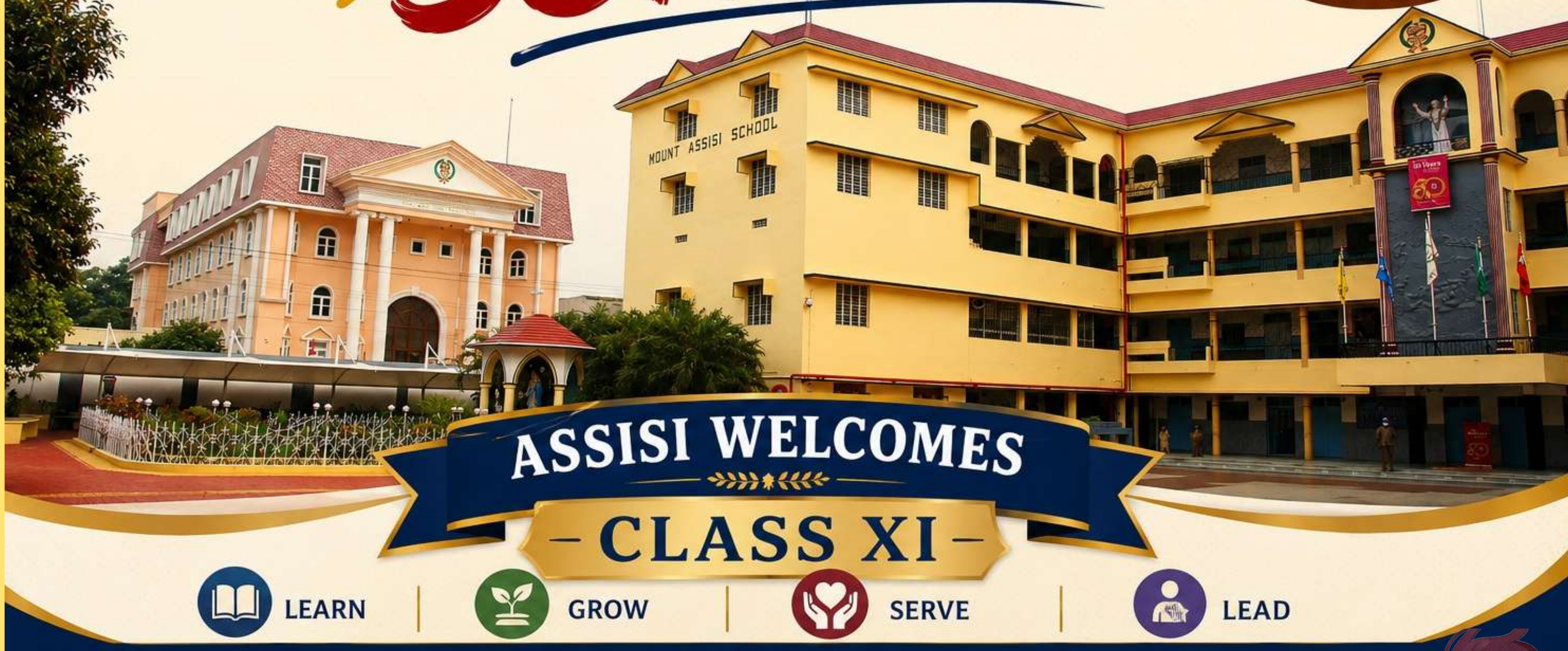

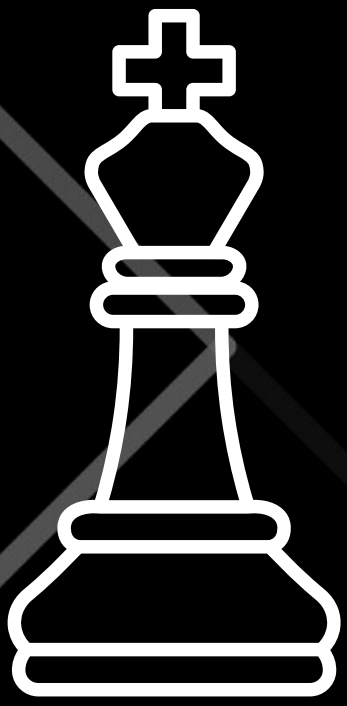

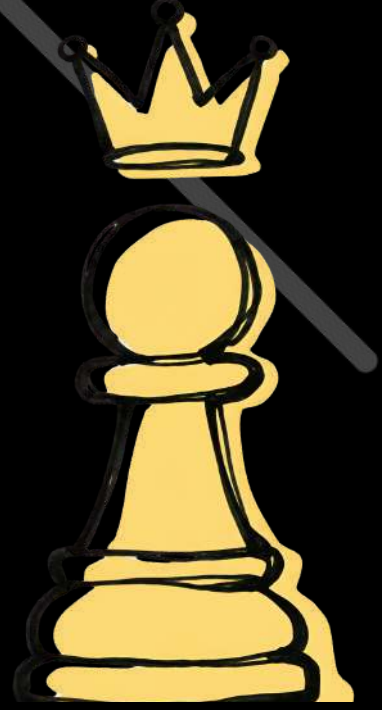
