



# FULBRIGHT SCHOLAR OF ASSISI

Satyam Mishra began his journey as a student in 1994 and became a part of the Mount Assisi School, Bhagalpur Family as a kindergarten (Grade -Nursery) student.

### "Chosen to pursue his Master's Degree at the renowned Harvard University."

He completed his Grade 10th (ICSE) in 2006 and 12th (ISC) in 2008. He graduated as an engineer from Manipal Institute of Technology, Manipal, Karnataka, where he earned a Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) degree in Information Technology and Communication. Following graduation, he joined Teach For India, a network partner at Teach For All, where he started working with children and young adults from underserved communities in Pune and Mumbai. Recognized for his unwavering commitment to combat educational inequity across the globe, including in some of the world's most conflict-ridden regions, Satyam was chosen as a 'Network Connector' at Teach For All.

His dedication took him to 18 countries, including Afghanistan, Ethiopia, South Africa, Nepal, Nigeria, Austria, Bulgaria, Slovakia, Japan, Portugal, Armenia, Romania, and Malaysia, where he served in various capacities.

His unique contributions led him to be the first Indian invited to teach and train teachers at the Malala Yousafzai All Girls' School, a school initiated by Malala Yousafzai herself for Syrian refugee girls in Beqaa, Lebanese-Syrian Border. Marking a significant milestone, Satyam became the first individual from Eastern India to be recognized as a Finalist for the UNESCO-Global Teacher Prize, Varkey Foundation - Dubai Cares, in 2021. His exceptional work did not go unnoticed by the United States of America, Department of State (Foreign Ministry), which selected him as a Fulbright Scholar in 2022. In 2024, his academic journey took a prestigious turn when he was chosen to pursue his Master's Degree at the renowned Harvard University.

The Assisi Family is proud of him as an alumnus and wishes him all the best for his future endeavours.

# TEACHER TRAINING IN ABACUS AND VEDIC MATHS



The demand for effective and innovative teaching methods is on the rise. In school curriculum, Vedic Mathematics and Abacus have emerged as powerful tools for transforming Mathematics as an easy and interesting subject.

To equip mathematics enthusiasts at Mount Assisi School with the tools needed for the Mathematical excellence, a two-day teacher training programme in Abacus and Vedic Mathematics was organized on 6th and 7th March 2024. Mr. Rajesh, Googoplex Edutech, Hyderabad was the resource person of the day.

Teachers teaching mathematics from classes 1 to 5 were trained in Abacus whereas teachers from classes 6 to 8 were given the training in Vedic Mathematics. Currently Abacus is taught form classes 1 to 5 and Vedic Mathematics from classes 6 to 8.

Introduction of Abacus and Vedic Mathematics with the school curriculum will surely help students conquer their fear of Mathematics, and this proactive step will ignite their passion for Mathematics.
