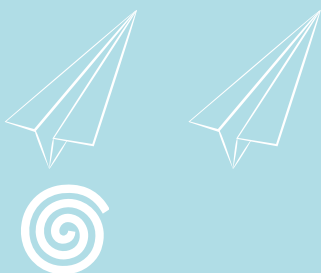
ASSISI TOPPERS ATTRIBUTE HARD WORK TO SUCCESS
